**Robert Hall Winery Receives “Best Cabernet Sauvignon” Honors**

San Francisco, CA – The San Francisco International Wine Competition recently released the results of their 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Wine Judging, with the **2007 Robert Hall Cabernet Sauvignon** receiving “Best Cabernet Sauvignon” and “Double Gold” honors from a selection of 436 Cabernet Sauvignons. Featuring entries from 28 countries, the competition evaluated over 3,800 wines during the three-day tasting. The San Francisco International Wine Competition is known for being one of the most globally inclusive and comprehensive wine competitions, with a high level of expertise amongst its judges. The award-winning wines of the competition will be showcased in a 13-city tour with “The Tasting Panel” magazine. The tour will visit select California cities in mid-September.

Robert Hall Winery, a family-owned winery located in the rolling hills of the Paso Robles appellation includes over 300 acres of Sustainability in Practice (SIP)<sup>™</sup> Certified vineyards. Owner Robert L. Hall settled in the Paso Robles AVA in the mid-90’s and launched the first vintage of Robert Hall wine in 2001.
